



My pool is GREEN!

#1) Use a Leaf Rake or Leaf Eater to remove as much of the leaves and debris from the pool as possible.

The chemicals will work 10x better if they don't have to contend with lots of organic material in the pool

#2) Add Chlorine - add 2 pucks to the skimmer and spread 6-7 cups of pool shock (pre-dissolved) around the pool

#3) Let pool run for 24 hrs (on the normal "filter" setting) and reassess at this point

Test the Chlorine level in the pool - if none & pool is still murky - shock it again (4-5 cups worth) and go back to #3

If chlorine level is OK to high and pool is still murky - add Flocculent agent (see directions)

If chlorine level is OK to high and pool is clearing, backwash filter and clean debris from the pool as it becomes visible.

Once pool is clear retest the water at Oasis and balance minerals as instructed.

N.B. Clean baskets at the pool skimmer and the pump, and backwash filter throughout process. (Keep system running and filtering at optimum level).
